Re: 2014 Dam Safety Inspection report for Golden Bear Mine

Under cover of this letter, please find the 2014 Dam Safety Inspection (DSI) report for the tailings facility at the North American Metals Corp - Golden Bear Mine and the results of the third-party review. The DSI report was prepared by the Engineer of Record, Knight Piesold Ltd and the DSI report was subsequently provided third-party review by AMEC Environment and Infrastructure.

North American Metals Corp (a wholly owned subsidiary of Goldcorp Inc.) is committed to ensuring the safe operation of all tailings facilities and dam structures under our control. The closed tailings facility at the Golden Bear Mine is in a passive care phase and does not contain a free water pond on top of the facility under normal conditions. A DSI is conducted every five years.

As outlined in the DSI and confirmed by the third-party engineer review, no immediate safety or stability concerns were noted for the Golden Bear Mine tailings storage facility or dam structures. The independent review found that there was insufficient information within the DSI to confirm the Low Consequence Classification for the Golden Bear tailings dam (see attached table).

No recommendations were made pertaining to maintenance in the DSI report. The tailings dam is 'considered to be in a stable state condition and sufficient experience has been gained with the structure and sufficient monitoring completed to demonstrate no further intervention is required'.
